- 1. The River Clyde is the ninth longest in the UK and the second in Scotland (River Tay being the longest).
- 2. Between 1712 and the present day 25,000 ships have been built on the River Clyde.
- 3. The River Clyde is crossed by 70 bridges.
- 4. The mouth of the River Clyde is called the Firth of Clyde, at its deepest it is 164m deep.
- 5. Many years ago, trade expanded, which meant bigger ships needed to travel up the Clyde, by 1880 large cargo ships could travel into the city.
